BOARD COMMUNIQUE #1 2020

I greet you in the name of our risen Lord Jesus Christ with the news that due to the 36 day Covid-19 pandemic lockdown, as well as the uncertainties which the immediate post lockdown period hold, your board has, after careful and prayerful consideration, taken the unanimous decision to postpone Men's Walk 123 and Lady's Walk 124 until 8 to 11 October and 15 to 18 October, respectively. Consequently Walks 127 and 128 which were scheduled for October, will now be rescheduled to May 2021. This is a great pity but regrettably totally unavoidable.

At this stage the Chrysalis Flights 125 and 126 are still scheduled to take place from 26 to 28 June. As these Flights are to be held on the campus of The Wykeham Collegiate High School during their winter recess, it is uncertain whether that will remain possible. That is entirely dependent upon what changes the fallout from the Covid-19 pandemic forces upon the school. We can but wait and see....

We have already had Face to Face Encounter 122 and with Encounter 129 planned for Howick in November, it is hoped that no date changes will be necessary.

While the full scale of the humanitarian tragedy and economic consequences of the Covid-19 pandemic are yet to be felt and while many uncertainties, disruptions and no doubt hardships still await us all, we must, as Christ followers, go forward with hope and the unshakeable belief that God is still in charge. I ask you therefore to please continue constantly to pray for these Emmaus Ministries as well as all the people of our land, our leaders and all those involved in the provision of essential services, many of whom put their lives at risk for our safety and protection.
